#### PROFILE

Agreenium, a public institution of scientific cooperation (établissement public de coopération scientifique, EPCS), was established in 2009 by three French ministries: agriculture, food, fisheries, rural affairs, and regional development; higher education and research; and foreign and European affairs.

The six founding members of Agreenium are Inra, Cirad, AgroParisTech, Agrocampus Ouest, Montpellier SupAgro, and the Institut national polytechnique de Toulouse.

Agreenium's mission is to strengthen the visibility, recognition, prestige, and international reach of French research and training in the agrosociences.

#### Major fields of study

The agrosociences include the following disciplines:

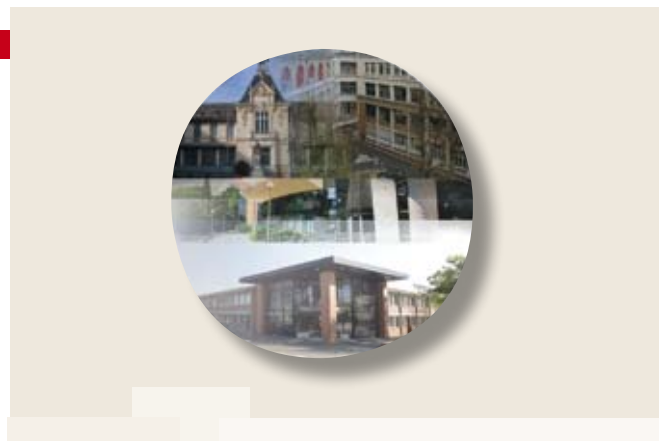
- Social sciences and economics as they pertain to rural development

The six founding members, all major actors in agronomic research and training, have pooled their skills and resources to have a greater impact at the international level.

The goal of the partnership is to contribute to the design of new approaches and models in agriculture, food production, and sustainable land and resource development in the global North and South through scientific achievements, innovation, training, and the diffusion of knowledge.
