PROFILE

Mines Alès is part of Institut Mines Télécom (IMT). IMT has been created in 2012 with 2 main objectives: be involved in the economic, industrial and technological development of the country and improve our higher educational system in a world facing internationalization.

Every year 300 students are awarded the «diplôme d'ingénieur» degree. Two third of the alumni had a training composed of core courses and advanced courses in 5 fields: Material Engineerin, Civil Engineering, Environment Energy and Risk, Complex Systems, Mineral ressources and underground work.

In 2016 Mines Alès hosted 153 international students coming from 34 countries.

Main programmes of study

At Mines Alès , after a common core curriculum, advanced courses are on offer in the fields of its 3 research laboratories: environment, complex systems and materials. More precisely 5 departments are offered to students: Civil Engineering, Materials and eco-design, Environment, energy and risks, Complex systems, Mineral resources and underground work. Besides these courses different masters including masters for international students are offered in the research centers.

Research

Research at Mines Alès is developing in 3 laboratories dedicated to: the environment and risks, materials, computing and complex systems. In order to best respond to societal demands 4 transversal axes have been defined: Risks, Ecomaterials, Health, Resources. They encourage the emergence of multidisciplinary research projects. Mines Alès is co-accredited in several master's, is part of several doctoral programs and is co-accredited for the award of the PhD.
