# Inp member of Hésam

With its fifteen member institutions, it has established an unprecedented alliance between the humanities and social sciences (SHS), the engineering sciences, the science of public and private governance, design, art and heritage.

Besides Inp, Hésam brings together the Conservatoire national des arts et métiers (CNAM), the Ecole des hautes études en sciences sociales (EHESS), the Ecole française d'Extrême-Orient (EFEO), the Ecole nationale des chartes (ENC), the Ecole nationale supérieure de création industrielle (ENSCI, Les Ateliers), the Ecole nationale supérieure d'arts et métiers (Arts et métiers Paris Tech), the Ecole pratique des hautes études (EPHE), the Ecole supérieure de commerce de Paris (ESCP Europe), the Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne, the Ecole nationale d'administration (ENA), the Institut national d'histoire de l'art (Inha), the Ecole du Louvre, the Fondation Maison des Sciences de l'Homme (FMSH) and the Institut national d'études démographiques (INED).

### MAIN PROGRAMMES OF STUDY

The master of restorer proposed by Inp has for ambition to prepare for the exercise of restorer's iob in 7 domains:

- Ceramics (metal, ceramic, enamel, glass): works of art, archaeological objects, scientific and technical objects:
- Graphic Arts and book : any work on paper base, of the drawing in the folding screen, but also the book:
- Textile Arts: costumes, textiles of furnishing an interior design, archaeological textiles, flags and hanners:
- Furniture : elements of furnishing, wooden objects with ornamental, technical or ethnographical character:
- Painting : any techniques, on every type of medium:

- Photography: positive and negative, the first ones proceeded to the most contemporary:
- Sculpture : stone, wood, plaster, earthenware, dressed or not in a decoration, and materials of the contemporary creation..

#### RESEARCH

Hésam (Hautes Etudes Sorbonne Arts et Métiers), established in 2010 as an alliance for research and higher education (PRES), is one of Europe's leading humanities and social sciences centres. It was named Hésam Université in December 2013.

Within Hésam, the Inp is involved in one of the Labex and in the Idex supported by Hésam.

# STRENGTHS

- Master's degree restorer of the heritage: more than 5 600 hours (corresponding to 300 ECTS) of education(teaching) over 5 years (theoretical, scientific, artistic, technical and practical teachings, the internships(training courses) and the construction sites(works) - school).
- In 2011, 12 construction sites school organized in France and abroad for duration accumulated of 14 weeks of interventions.
- Idex Paris Novi Mundi University: 24 000 students, about 3 000 teachers, and researchers, 91 units of research, 17 doctoral schools, 75 classified Master's degrees and 25 Master's degrees labélisés by the conference of Grandes Écoles.
- Scientific and cultural distribution: Fund of the libraryof the department of the restorers: 60 000 notes - Fund of the center of documentary resources: 14 000 works and 27 000 feature stories - 1 600 available digital resources in the digital library
