IRIS Sup' was established in 2002 by the Institute for International and Strategic Affairs (IRIS), a nationally and internationally recognised French think tank working on geopolitical and strategic international affairs.

IRIS Sup' offers nationally accredited postgraduate degree programmes designed to meet the needs of today's workplace - targeting people willing to develop their skills and competencies, seeking for a position in an international environment.

◆ MAIN PROGRAMMES OF STUDY

At IRIS Sup', we offer two postgraduate degree programmes recognised by the French Government (RNCP titles): - International Strategy Analyst (ASI), focusing on applied geopolitics; and Humanitarian Manager (MPIHD). These two-year programmes are open to candidates who graduated with a three-year undergraduate degree. Candidates with a four-year degree may apply directly to the second year programme.

Year 1 at IRIS Sup' (admission with an undergraduate degree)

Year 1 programme is the first step for students who graduated with a three-year undergraduate degree with no professional experience. For students with advanced, science-stream degrees, Year 1 also provides the necessary foundation in political issues, economics and international diplomacy before beginning Year 2 specialisations.

Year 2 at IRIS Sup' (admission with a graduate degree):

The **International Strategy Analyst (ASI)** programme offers three specialisations for students to improve their analytical abilities and decision-making skills in international environments: 1) Geopolitics and foresight; 2) Geoeconomics and risk management; and 3) Defence, security and crisis management.

The **Humanitarian Manager (MH)** programme allows students to develop their skills and competencies in supporting fieldwork operations, project management (PLM) and programme planning in three specialised fields: Strategy; Operations; and Advocacy and

effective communications. Students acquire skills and competencies throughout projects in partnership with a wide range of non-governmental organisations.

◆ RESEARCH

IRIS Sup' is the only school in France attached to a think tank, IRIS is one of the country's leading research centres in international relations. Some of IRIS' fields of expertise include: Defence and Security; International balances of power and Globalisation; Energy and Environment; Humanitarian and Development; Sport and International Relations; Regional areas: Europe, Western Americas, Russia-CIS, sub-Saharan Africa, the Middle East, the Mediterranean region and Asia. For over 15 years, IRIS Sup' students have benefitted from IRIS' expertise in these various areas.

◆ STRENGTHS
