Since 1947, the École des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales (EHESS) has been home to researchers and students from all over the world and from all walks of life, with the aim of bringing together all the social science disciplines to understand the complexity of societies. Through its cultural openness and its research seminar practice, the EHESS has been an "incubator" in the social sciences. It has directly contributed and continues to contribute to the emergence of numerous paradigms in the social and human sciences, from the works of Claude Lévi-Strauss, Jacques Le Goff, Pierre Bourdieu and Jacques Derrida, to those of Françoise Héritier and Thomas Piketty.

MAIN PROGRAMMES OF STUDY

EHESS occupies a unique spot in the landscape of French education and research. It trains by and through research master degree students and PhDs in every discipline of the humanities and social sciences among them history, anthropology, sociology, litterature, economics, geography, linguistics, cognitive sciences, political sciences, philosophy, or even mathematics. Around twenty master's degree courses and several

doctoral schools are offered to the students.

A publishing house, Éditions de l'EHESS, helps to disseminate the knowledge produced within the institution.

With 150 visiting professors each year from universities all over the world and 3,000 students enrolled (almost half of them are foreigners), EHESS is an institution on a human scale with a strong international vocation.

A hundreds of agreements with foreign universities facilitate student mobility, among other things. It is regarded as one of Europe's leading centres for social science research.
