Created in 1966, INSA Rennes is a member of the INSA Group, the leading French network of state graduate and post graduate engineering schools, composed of 7 INSA in France, 6 INSA partner schools and 1 international INSA in Morocco. With almost 2 000 students, INSA Rennes is a prestigious "Grande Ecole", a graduate and post graduate school of sensible proportions. INSA Rennes delivers high level scientific training conforming to the highest official European standards: 8 Masters of Engineering, 8 Masters by Research and 3 PhD programs.

INSA Rennes has a very selective recruitment : it accepts only the best students, on basis of academic value of their dossier and interview. Subsidized by the state, INSA engineer training is accessible to students from all social backgrounds. International students are eligible for admission at all levels. Also welcomed are exchange students wishing to spend a semester or more at INSA under an inter-institutional exchange agreement.
