Born in 2019 from the merger of the universities of Paris Diderot, Paris Descartes and Institut de physique du globe de Paris (IPGP), Paris Cité is a world-class multidisciplinary university with one of the largest student and research community in Paris and its region (63 000 students, 4 600 teachers-researchers and 2 700 administrative staff).

Structured into 3 major Faculties (Faculty of Health, Faculty of Sciences and Faculty of Society and Humanities), and with 21 doctoral schools, Université Paris Cité offers many students the possibility to study, from the end of secondary education, up to the highest French diploma: The habilitation thesis to supervise research (DAEU, DUT, Licence, Master, Doctorate, HDR) in all the major disciplinary fields.

◆ MAIN PROGRAMMES OF STUDY

International mobility and innovative teaching methods play an important part in the nearly 800 degree and diploma courses offered in initial and continuing education at the Université Paris Cité.

Thus, students have the opportunity to study in France and abroad in fields as diverse as Health (Medicine, Pharmacy, Odontology, Dentistry, Nursing), Sciences (Life Sciences, Fundamental and Biomedical Sciences, Chemistry, Computer Mathematics, Life Frontiers, Physics, Engineering) and Humanities (Arts, Literature, Languages, Humanities and Social Sciences, Geography, History, Sports and Physical Activities as well as Law, Economics and Management).

There are, in addition, a number of courses offered by the Paris IUT, as well as the interdisciplinary and international courses.

◆ RESEARCH

In a French landscape that is being restructured into major clusters, with the ambition of recreating several world-class universities in

France, Université Paris Cité represents a leading force in research, already highly visible nationally and internationally thanks to its laboratories and its 4 500 internationally recognised researchers and teacher-researchers in a variety of specialties, covering the main fields of knowledge.

Its fields of high-level research and its 118 research structures and units, closely linked to its multidisciplinary and innovative training, position it as one of the top ranked higher education institutions in international rankings. Nearly one out of ten scientific articles published in France comes from the laboratories of Université Paris Cité. As the leading

French university in terms of citations per article, it awards 8% of doctorates at the national level.
