The I-Factory harnesses the talent and creativity of students, the scientific excellence of researchers and the technological and scientific platforms to develop innovative projects as well as events. The Entrepreneurship Center aims to help students acquire an entrepreneurial spirit and learn the skills they will need as young entrepreneurs.

Social and environmental responsibility.

The stakes regarding climate and environmental issues requires all public players to play an active role in France's energy, ecological and social transition. Along with its 35 institutions, the Université de Lyon commits to an ambitious policy on reducing its environmental impact, particularly in light of campus renovation, as well as social measures to ensure the equity of all its target audiences.

Disseminating knowledge.

The Université de Lyon's science and society initiatives promote interaction between the academic world and civil society. They help to disseminate, share and spark discussion about knowledge, through the PopSciences web portal, scientific events such as the Science Fair and conferences throughout the year, and a bi-annual research magazine.

Three schemes for welcoming talents.

Students Welcome Desk, for international students arriving in Lyon and Saint-Étienne between September and December | Espace Ulys, EURAXESS center of the Université de Lyon, to help international scientists and doctoral students settle in the area | Collegium de Lyon, an Institute for Advanced Study, for international researchers who wish to develop an innovative research project.
