It initiates and carries out major projects for the future of the site in the fields of master and doctoral studies, research and innovation, student disability and accessibility, student life, digital innovation, science-society links, international or campus real estate strategy.

◆ RESEARCH

Research and doctoral study are essential to the mission of the Université de Lyon. Three main research thrusts / sciences and engineering / biosciences and health, and social sciences guided by three major themes: global health and society / modeling of complex systems; and engineering for sustainable development.
