Université Paris-Saclay was created by the combined efforts of universities, grandes écoles and research bodies, and is one of Europe's and the world's leading universities in the fields of science and engineering, life sciences and health, and the humanities and social sciences. Its scientific policy closely links research and innovation, and focuses on both fundamental and applied sciences to meet the major challenges facing society.

Université Paris-Saclay brings together :

- 3 university technology institutes: IUT Cachan, IUT Orsay, IUT Sceaux
- 1 university engineering school: Polytech Paris-Saclay

- 2 associate member universities: Université de Versailles Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines, Université d'Evry

Université Paris-Saclay has an excellent international reach and coordinates the EUGLOH European Alliance.

## ◆ RESEARCH

With more than 220 laboratories, 500 experimental platforms, 8,100 researchers and teacher-researchers and strengthened partnerships with six national research organisations (CEA, CNRS, Inrae, Inria, Inserm and Onera), Université Paris-Saclay represents 13% of French research.

From fundamental to applied research, Université Paris-Saclay is committed to responding to the challenges of knowledge and society, and in particular to seven societal challenges: health and well-being; energy, climate, environment, sustainable development; biodiversity, agriculture and food; digital transformation and AI; transport and mobility; aeronautics and space, and industrial renewal.

The university is home to 4,500 doctoral students in 21 doctoral schools, 40% of whom are international.

## ◆ STRENGTHS

- Dedicated support for international students: a range of services and facilities are available to international students, doctoral candidates and researchers from the moment they arrive in France, including the Online Welcome Desk, an international mentoring programme, help desks to assist with administrative formalities, French as a foreign language courses, etc.

- International recognition and visibility: Université Paris-Saclay is ranked among the top 12 universities in the world according to the Shanghai ranking (ARWU) 2024, and is also the most renowned French university in the world according to the Times Higher Education ranking of the world reputation of universities.

- An ecosystem conducive to innovation: located in one of Europe's most important economic and research areas, the university has set up a range of facilities to encourage the transformation of research results into innovations with a strong economic and societal impact, including seven incubators, a FabLab network, a technology transfer acceleration company, a design centre and training courses dedicated to entrepreneurship, etc.

## ◆ LOCATION

Located to the south of Paris in a vast territory, the Université Paris-Saclay benefits from a geographical position that favours both its international visibility and close links with its socio-economic partners. Its campuses are located at Gif-sur-Yvette, Orsay, Palaiseau, Sceaux, Cachan, Kremlin-Bicêtre, Evry and Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines.
