In November 2018, the French government voted to implement differentiated tuition fees for international students.

The payment of differentiated registration fees by non-EU students (with the exception of those who are not liable) will come into effect within the institution at the start of the 2022-2023 academic year.

The amount of these fees will be €2,770 for a Bachelor's degree and €3,770 for a Master's degree. Doctoral students will be exempted.
