Founded in November 1991, ULCO began its first academic year in September 1992

It is a multi-campus university, located in three port cities in the north of France: Boulogne, a fishing port, Calais, a passenger port, and Dunkerque, an industrial port, as well as the inland city of Saint-Omer.

A multi-disciplinary university, ULCO now has 10,000 students (including 1,100 international students from 75 countries) on the 4 campuses and offers more than 100 nationally State recognized degree programmes.

ULCO is composed of 12 Departments, 1 Technological University Institute (IUT), a Business School (ISCID-CO), an **Engineers School (EILCO) and a Lifelong Learning Centre (FCU).**

We have chosen "A university with a human dimension " as motto for our university. What do we mean by that? It is the conception we have of education and which encompasses, among other things, the following:

- We prefer interactive courses in small groups, and avoid as much as possible ex-cathedra lectures in aulas.
- · We have an accessible teaching and training staff that is always there to lend a listening ear to our students.
- A buddy system exists since many years to help new students to acclimatize.
- Our Career Orientation Office SUAIO has developed study units, compulsory in all degrees, to allow students to define and refine their career objectives.
- We pay special attention to international students who can count on the assistance of our International Affairs Office that offers several services to guarantee a quick and trouble-free integration, among them assistance to residence permit application and other administrative

procedures, and free French courses.
