Université Jean Monnet, founded in 1969, is a comprehensive university enrolling approximately 17,000 students.

It consists of

- 5 faculties: Arts, letters, and languages; humanities and social sciences; law; science and technology; and medicine.
- 1 department: politic sciences
- 4 institutes: Institute of business administration; Télécom Saint-Etienne (a school of engineering); and the Saint-Etienne and Roanne university institutes of technology.

◆ MAIN PROGRAMMES OF STUDY

Université Jean Monnet de Saint-Etienne offers nearly 300 programs leading to national diplomas in arts, letters, and languages; humanities and social sciences; law, economics, and management; sports; health; and science and technology. The university is an active participant in international projects financed through various programs:

◆ RESEARCH

Shaping the university's science policy are 422 faculty members and research scholars organized into thematic research units. 34 research units are active in the principal

academic disciplines, 5 overarching entities (chemistry, health, bio-imaging, university presses, religious and lay studies).

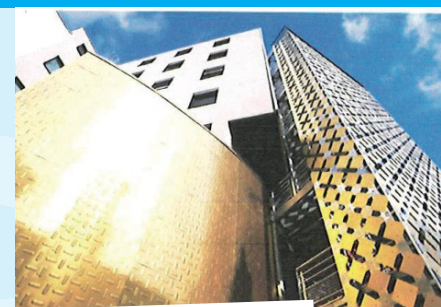
