

PREPARE FOR ENTRANCE EXAMS

Objectives:

- to help students discover their unique artistic personality and mode of creative expression; to develop technique on the basis of these discoveries;
- to prepare students for entrance exams for admission to schools of art overseen by the Ministry of Culture and schools of architecture;
- to help students assemble a portfolio of original artistic work required for admission to degree programs (such as the DNMADE, DNA and DEEA, among others).

Admission upon evidence of eligibility, interview, and samples of artistic work.
 Time commitment: 30–35 hours of coursework per week + 2–3 hours of homework daily.

Specialized public schools of art and design

- 5 schools (Écoles Nationales Supérieures) grant masters-equivalent degrees in applied arts, plastic arts, visual arts, conception and creation, industrial design, fabric design, and photography
- 2 schools offer programs in film and theater ranging from two to five years

Schools of art overseen by the Ministry of Culture

- 45 national and territorial schools of art and design in 58 cities are under the oversight of the Ministry of Culture (10 also under the oversight of the Ministry of Higher Education, Research, and Innovation).
- Programs in art, design, and communication are organized into 3 cycles or stages, the first two capped by national diplomas: the Licence (or bachelor) after 3 years and the Master after 5 years. Various post-master diplomas are also available.

- The **Diplôme National d'Art (DNA)** is 3 years of postsecondary study and carries 180 ECTS credits. It is equivalent to the *Licence*.

- The **Diplôme National Supérieur d'Expression Plastique (DNSEP)** is 5 years of study and carries an additional 120 ECTS credits. It is equivalent to a Master.


Post-master's training can be also available under collaborative arrangements with other art schools of a university.



SCHOOLS OF APPLIED ARTS MASTER TECHNIQUE



A network of four public institutions of great renown—Boulle, Estienne, Duperré, and ENSAAMA—overseen by the Ministry of National Education + public and private secondary schools under contract that deliver the advanced degrees in applied arts.

Two national diplomas in very specialized fields: graphic art and design (media and multimedia); space design (interior architecture, lifestyle, set design); fashion; textiles and environments; arts and crafts (textiles, jewelry, books, glass, ceramics):

- The Diplôme National des Métiers d'Art et du Design (DNMADE) is 3 years of postsecondary study and is equivalent to the *Licence*.
- The Diplôme Supérieur d'Arts Appliqués (DSAA) is equivalent to 5 years of postsecondary study.

SCHOOLS OF ARCHITECTURE ARCHITECTURE, URBAN PLANNING, LANDSCAPE DESIGN



A network of 20 public schools operating under the oversight of the Ministry of Culture and the Ministry of Higher Education, Research, and Innovation + 2 schools authorized to confer degrees recognized as equivalent to those of the 20 public institutions.

Degrees and professional qualification:

- The Diplôme d'Études en Architecture (DEEA) is 3 years of postsecondary and is equivalent to a *Licence*
- The Diplôme d'État d'Architecte (DEA) requires 5 years of postsecondary and is equivalent to a Master
- Some schools (Clermont-Ferrand, Lyon, Marne-La-Vallée, Marseille, Nantes, Paris-Belleville, Paris-La Villette, Toulouse) offer a dual degree in architecture and engineering in partnership with schools of engineering. Graduates receive the *Diplôme d'Architecte* and the title of *Ingénieur*.





SCHOOLS OF ARCHITECTURE ARCHITECTURE, URBAN PLANNING, LANDSCAPE DESIGN




- The HMONP (Habilitation à exercer la Maîtrise d'Oeuvre en son Nom Propre) recognizes the architect's legal capacity to direct projects independently and to obtain a building permit. It requires a sixth year of study and completion of an internship.
- The DSA (Diplôme de Spécialisation et d'Approfondissement) in architecture, a national diploma, and the DPEA (a diploma granted by many architecture schools) mark completion of 1–2 year undergraduate programs.
- The **Doctorate** in architecture requires 3 years of work in a research unit at one of 40 schools of architecture. Each units is affiliated with a university doctoral department.

UNIVERSITIES AIM FOR A CAREER IN THE ARTS OR CULTURE



The universities offer programs in art that are primarily historical or theoretical in emphasis. Programs are offered at all levels: *Licence* (3 years of postsecondary study), *Master* (5 years), Doctorate (8 years).

Broad art-related disciplines:

- performing arts: film criticism, history of stagecraft, dance, music, cinema, etc.
- visual arts: history of art, analysis of works of art, aesthetics, etc.
- history of art: history of artistic creation, painting, sculpure, architecture; archaeology, historic and cultural preservation, land-use planning, etc.
- Management of cultural assets and institutions; presentation and interpretation of art and culture
- Research in art-related fields in more than a hundred scholarly teams affiliated with 30 doctoral departments distributed throughout France

SCHOOLS OF HERITAGE PRESERVATION PROTECT HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

Three public schools of heritage preservation (INP, EDL, and ENC) offer high-level programs:

- **knowledge** of heritage resources (art historians, guides and presenters)
- preservation (heritage conservators, architects specializing in historic monuments, restorers, etc.)

Degree programs at all major levels:

- Licence from a university: majors in history of art and archaeology, restoration and preservation of cultural heritage, landuse planning, etc. + Licence-level DNA from EDL with major in conservation-restoration
- Master from a university: concentrations in archaeology, archives, cultures and societies, history of art and heritage, conservation and restoration of cultural assets, museum studies, architecture + diplomas in specialized fields from specialized schools, such as: ancient archives (from ENC); management of media heritage (from INA); heritage restoration (from EDL), with concentrations in fired arts (metal, glass, ceramics, enamel), graphic arts, textile arts, furniture, painting (canvas, murals), photography, sculpture; state diploma as heritage conservator in archives, archaeology, inventory, historic monuments, museums, scientific, technical, and natural heritage.

CONSERVATORIES Music, dance, dramatic art

France has 4 major types of conservatory:

- 2 national conservatories of music and dance (CNSMD): one in Paris; the other in Lyon
- Regional conservatories (CRR)
- Departmental conservatories (CRD)
- Commune-level conservatories (CRC).

Through partnerships with universities, conservatory diplomas have been harmonized with the three-level system (Licence-Master-Doctorate) :

- Diplôme d'université (DU) in musical presentation (2 years of postsecondary study)
- Diplôme d'état (DE) in music education (3 years)
- Diplôme national supérieur professionnel de musicien (DNSPM) in musical performance (3 years)
- Diplôme de 2nd cycle supérieur from the CNSMDs of Paris and Lyon (5 years, master level)
- Diploma in musical pedagogy from the CNSMDs of Paris and Lyon (5 years, master level)

PRIVATE SCHOOLS MUSIC, DESIGN, ART, FILM, ILLUSTRATION,...

- Programs, often costly, require 3 to 5 years of postsecondary study.
- Diplomas are specific to the conferring institution—that is, they are not French national diplomas.
- Some programs appear in the RNCP, the national registry of occupational certifications, under the authority of the France Compétences (**www.francecompetences.fr**), an official body operating under ministerial supervision, that is responsible for assessing professional and vocational credentials and classifying them according to the level of employment for which they qualify their holders.

Note: France's universities are presently the only educational institutions in the country authorized to grant master's degrees. Use of the term master on the websites of some private institutions sometimes creates confusion, which the National Commission works to dispel.

REGISTRATION FEES

Public universities

- Licence: 170 euros for students from the European Economic Area and Switzerland // 2,770 euros for international students outside the European Economic Area.
- Master: 243 euros for students from the European Economic Area and Switzerland, 3,770 euros for international students outside the European Economic Area.
- Doctorate: 380 euros

Exemptions are possible for students subject to differentiated fees. They can be offered on CampusArt by:

- host establishments according to their attractiveness strategy. The exemptions offered by these establishments can be total or partial;
- diplomatic posts according to their budgetary envelope and their policy vis-à-vis excellent candidates or their university cooperation strategy.

Public Higher Schools of Art and Design and National Higher Schools of Public Architecture

- Diplôme National d'Art (DNA) License degree: from 350 euros for students in public art schools
- Diplôme d'Etudes En Architecture (DEEA) License degree: from 370 euros for students in public architecture schools
- Diplôme National Supérieur d'Expression Plastique (DNSEP) Master degree: from 400 euros for students in public art schools
- Diplôme d'Etat d'Architecture (DEA) Master degree: from 512 euros for students in public architecture schools

To these amounts may be added additional costs for specific services.

Public schools of art and architecture are not subject to differentiated fees.

Private schools

• The cost of enrollment in private establishments is significantly higher (generally 3,000 to 20,000 euros per year).

TO APPLY

Differentiated fees: Public higher art schools and national higher schools of architecture are not affected by the implementation of differentiated fees.

To apply for art and design colleges:

- Art and design colleges are not connected to the Etudes en France platform
- · CampusArt: ESAD application platform available for all nationalities and all levels of entry to the course on www.campusart.org

Applicants from a country with an EEF procedure apply through CampusArt (or after school) and then submit their admission to the pre-consular phase of EEF.

European and non-European applicants where there is no EEF apply through CampusArt (or through the school).

To apply to national higher schools of architecture:

- CampusArt: ENSA application platform available for all nationalities and all levels of entry to the course on www.campusart.org;
- European candidates: Parcoursup procedure for entry into the first year + internal selection procedure by ENSA, then if selection compulsory interview with a jury;
- Non-European applicants living abroad: the yellow DAP (or yellow file):
- Studies in France platform for students residing in the countries concerned;
- countries where EEF does not exist, yellow DAP available in the cultural services of French embassies abroad which are responsible for receiving DAPs, summoning candidates not exempted from the French Knowledge Test (TCF / DAP) and " send all compliant files to the relevant ENSAs.

Non-European applicants are subject to a French language test, the TCF DAP.



PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF ART ENTRANCE EXAMS_TRANSFERS_EQUIVALENCE

Admission into the first year of art school is by **examination**. Applicants must hold a French baccalauréat or equivalent secondary school diploma.

The admission process unfolds in **two phases** following consideration of the applicant's secondary school record:

- 3 tests: artistic practice, general knowledge, foreign language
- 1 interview with the admission committee based on a portfolio presented by candidates, who must be prepared to talk about their work.

Each school determines the details of the examination process (which may include proof of eligibility).

Transfer admissions of students who have completed at least one year of study at another school of art overseen by the Ministry of Culture are done by committees formed for the purpose by each school.

Equivalence committees are convened to consider the cases of French students wishing to transfer from an institution other than a school of art and of international students who have begun their studies in another country. Applications from the latter must be translated into French and certified.

Creative occupations

Visual artist—painter, engraver, sculptor, illustrator, cartoonist, photographer, videographer, filmmaker, documentarist, video game designer, graphic designer, product designer, space designer, fabric designer, set designer, museum display designer...

Occupations involving expertise

Art director, manager of art projects, communications director, developer of products and services, exhibition organizer/curator, art critic, consultant/appraiser, dealer, auctioneer, gallery owner/manager, broker...

Cultural occupations

Organizer of cultural events (fairs, festivals), promoter of tourism, communications director/manager, event producer, cultural presenter/interpreter, institutional administrator, staff/manager of performing arts company...

Crafts, applied arts

France's endowment of skill in arts and crafts is represented by more than 38,000 workshops and 100,000 artisans practicing 217 distinct professions divided into 19 specialties. These include graphic art and design (media and multimedia); space design (interior architecture, lifestyle, set design); fashion; textiles and environments; arts and crafts (textiles, jewelry, books, glass, ceramics).

Architecture

Graduate architects work for individuals, organizations, businesses, and government. They contribute to projects of various types and scale: conception, representation, design, interior architecture, lighting, set design, heritage preservation, conservation and restoration, space design, living environments, landscape design, and urban and regional planning, among others. Upstream from supervising construction projects, architects work in teaching, research, programming, and technical consulting.
