You can earn a degree in just two years!

A nationally accredited master's degree or the equivalent opens the way to doctoral studies.

COMPLETION OF SECONDARY SCHOOL + **BACCALAURÉAT** OR EQUIVALENT

Postsecondary degrees in France are attuned to the common European system: bachelor (known in France as the *Licence*), master, and doctorate. The system is based on the number of years or semesters successfully completed since secondary school. With each period completed, the student earns a certain number of "ECTS* credits."

*ECTS, the **European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System**, is a system of cumable academic credits transferable throughout Europe. One year represents 60 ECTS credits.
