CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

New funding programs for international students and researchers: Master's, doctoral, postdoctoral, and short stay

"Make Our Planet Great Again" themes: Climate sciences, the energy transition, earth systems















1 CO-FINANCING FOR THREE-YEAR DOCTORAL PROGRAMS

(approximately 20 grants available)

Co-financing of €50,000 is available to French institutions wishing to host doctoral candidates for three years of research on the themes of the "Make Our Planet Great Again"* initiative.

Host institutions must agree to provide at least €50,000 in co-financing support over three years. Institutions initiate the process by proposing PhD topics. If their proposals are accepted, they then recruit doctoral candidates to perform the proposed research.

May 5-June 12, 2018:

- > Evaluation of PhD topics/candidates
- June 14, 2018:
- > Successful PhD topics/candidates are notified

Beginning September 2018:

> Candidates report to participating institutions

2 CO-FINANCING FOR POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCH

(approximately 20 grants available)

Co-financing of up to €50,000 is available to French institutions of higher education and research that wish to host a postdoctoral researcher for 12 to 24 months of work on one of the themes of the "Make Our Planet Great Again"* initiative.

Host institutions must agree to provide 50% of the postdoctoral researcher's support. Individual researchers initiate the application in collaboration with the host institution, which supplies a letter agreeing to provide co-financing.

FINANCING FOR SHORT STAYS

(approximately 40 grants available)

Financing is available to support research periods of 14 days' to 5 months' duration for international doctoral candidates, postdocs, and senior faculty wishing to conduct research at a French institution on one of the themes of the "Make Our Planet Great Again"* initiative.

Mobility assistance will be provided in the form of a *per diem* (from 65€ to 120€/day) paid over the entire period of the stay.

Candidates must accompany their application with a supporting letter from a French host institution.

4 MASTER'S EXCELLENCE GRANTS

(approximately 50 grants available)

Master's excellence grants of 12 and 24 months' duration (1,060€/month) are available to students seeking to enroll in a French institution to pursue a course of study linked to one of the themes of the "Make Our Planet Great Again"* initiative.

Candidates for the excellence grants must submit their application together with a letter of admission to a Master's program (first or second year).
